

Garter Stitch Ribbing

This simple combination of knit and purl stitches creates a lovely kind of ribbing. The ribbing is actually a series of garter stitch ribs, and is highlighted by rows of simple stockinette stitch. When two colors are used, the result is pretty spectacular. However, the stitch is pretty with just one color as well.

Materials Needed:

Your choice of yarn(s) in whatever amount needed for the size you are making.

Knitting needles in a size recommended with your yarn.

Scissors

Cast on any number of stitches.

Row 1: knit all stitches

Row 2: knit all stitches

Row 3: knit all stitches

Row 4: knit all stitches

Row 5: knit all stitches

Row 6: if using a second color, add it here. Knit all stitches.

Row 7: purl all stitches

Row 8: knit all stitches

Row 9: purl all stitches

Row 10: If using two colors, go back to original color. Knit all stitches.

Row 11: knit all stitches

Row 12: knit all stitches

Row 13: knit all stitches

Row 15: knit all stitches

Row 16: knit all stitches

To continue, repeat rows 6 - 9, followed by rows 10 - 16, until you have reached the desired length.

Bind off.
